MAIN FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

- Work in partnership with various venues to ensure they create a safe environment putting health and safety measures in place as
- · Responsible for all safety equipment, resources and governance
- Compliance with up-to-date Health and Safety legislation
- Take responsibility for investigating Health & Safety issues which arise as a result of a DSG organised training session, event or competition
- To communicate Health and Safety information to the committee, members and staff
- · Undertake risk assessments where required and to maintain records of documents
- Lead by example and take responsibility for the provision of relevant health and safety training for other volunteers, staff or committee members
- Ensure all athletes, coaches, volunteers and other members attending sessions understand & comply with the guidelines
- Ensure that all contact details of athletes, umpires and spectators are collected through an opt in Self-Declaration form which will be retained safely for 21 days and then disposed of in line with GDPR regulations.
